1. National Soils Database

The homepage for this project is <http://erc.epa.ie/nsdb>. From here you can access information about the project, link to a WebGIS viewer to browse the data and link to a data request form to allow you to order electronic copies of the data.

2. HydroStats

This is a WebGIS tool that provides flow estimates for an ungauged location based on data interpolated from other candidate stations. You must register to gain a password to access the site: register at the home page of the site <http://watermaps.wfdireland.ie/HydroTool>
