Reporting to the Supervisor, the Geologist is responsible for conducting multidisciplinary geoscience activities, sample and data collection, data analysis and integration, and associated reporting for exploration projects in the Irish Midlands. Working collaboratively within a small team, your focus will be on applying leading practice geoscience, delivery of quality technical work, and learning how to safely and efficiently execute projects toward discovery. The Geologist is tasked with the following key elements:

**Responsibilities:**

- Under the general direction of the Supervisor, assists in the development of exploration programs and budgets; manages timely and scale-appropriate geological field work (geologic mapping/ logging, geophysical surveys, sampling, drilling) and utilizes all data to generate integrated interpretations and recommendations;
- Prepares comprehensive government, partner and technical reports, maps and presentation materials with clear conclusions and recommendations on proposals for further work if merited;
- Communicates with Supervisor on a regular basis, and communicates with and mentors Technicians;
- Ensures activities are consistent with EHS policies and management systems, as guided by the Charter of Corporate Responsibility, the Code of Business, Environmental and Health and Safety Practices and the EHS Management Standards;
- Promotes a safety leadership culture by ensuring that proper safety practices are followed in accordance with Teck's health and safety policies;
